Description

DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES

The actually implemented program followed the daily tasks and activities of the Agenda, including the accommodation, transportation and catering of foreign participants. The meeting was carried out under the management of the host Local Government of Town Újszilvás. The professional programs were hosted by the Culture House of Újszilvás, with adequate technical service. The locations of the additional programs were local institutions and businesses, and a Budapest visit program also took place.

SEPTEMBER 25, 2023 (MONDAY)

Arrival of participants during the day, 16.00: transfer from Budapest Airport by the host partner, accommodation in a selected hotel: 'Györgyey Kastély Panzió és Étterem', Tápiógyörgye. Welcome dinner in the hotel.

THEMATIC PROGRAMS

SEPTEMBER 26, 2023 (TUESDAY)

The meeting was opened by *Dr. Csaba Petrányi*, mayor of Újszilvás, who presented the settlement and the latest developments, and held a conversation with the participants.

SEMINAR: As an introduction to the thematic work of the meeting, ppt presentation of 'Green Strategies adopted by EU Strategies/Actions/Programmes as concerns the Green Transition and Youth Participation' was delivered by *an* expert of European projects. The following topics were discussed with the 74 slides:

- European Climate Pact
- European Green Deal
- Next Generation EU
- National Recovery and Resilience Plans
- EU Youth Strategy
- Year of Youth 2022
- European Youth Policy Initiatives

DEBATE AND DISCUSSION: "Local Green Power" In this debate the project partners, who had been prepared for this task, presented their territorial possibilities in using the local resources for green opportunities and creating sustainable future.

The host partner LG Town Újszilvás demonstrated the development of its green energy programs with ppt presentation, and the results were discussed with the mayor of the town in questions and answers form.

The Best Practices of Town Újszilvás was also presented in ppt format, summarizing the different renewable energy sources used up, as well as the municipal work programs which created job places and contributed to the maintenance of the local work force and the development the life conditions.

INTERGENERATIONAL WORKSHOP: Workshop was held about different points of view of the current situation of the local green power to promote reflection.

Participants were asked to write short answers to the following seven questions:

1. Who is Ms. Katalin Karikó, a person who has relation to the COVID vaccination?
2. Which European program do you think important and effective as regards the green purposes?
3. What are the main obstacles to achieving the goals?
4. How much do you trust in achieving the EU aims?
5. What do you wait from the next European Parliament in relation to the green politics?
6. What are the main reasons of damaging the environment and the life circumstances?
7. What do you do yourself for helping the situation,

Visit to Elementary School of Újszilvás:

The director and a teacher of the school presented some special activities of the school which are related to environmental-green-energy saving programs and policy.

SEPTEMBER 27, 2023 (WEDNESDAY)

Study visit to look at the local municipal facilities related to the subject of the project: swimming pool, solar power plant, geothermal heating system, local work programs: orchard, fruit juice manufacture, etc.

Study visit to see local firms and companies as Best Practices: Presentation of different actions of the local firms and companies as well as some sustainable and green success stories which improve the local youth position through sustainable and green future and motivate them to joint. Best practices of local workforce management initiatives and good examples of enterprises in Town Újszilvás: FERZOL Ltd (metal sheet processing), Bolyhos Pálinka (brandy) Manufacture, Peng Farm, etc.

Visit to Budapest, capital of Hungary, to see historical sites in the castle area. Participants was transferred to the location by bus, organized by the host partner.
