- Goup 4 – reducing ecological footprint locally - how prefer local product and increase local activities (backyard – fruit, vegetables, etc.) how could degrease ecological footprint locally (ideas, recommendation – comparing local and international options – differences and common values)

- partners from each group report conclusions and provide recommendations to the local government/family etc.

- each group's spokesperson has 5-10 minutes briefing possibility to present joint experience, differences, joint values, good practice, etc. - Encouragement of participants to bring up ideas and proposals for enhancement of climate policies and to become Green Ambassadors.
